Sample Lesson Plan

Stone Age / Bronze Age / Iron Age - exploring library resources & using information retrieval skills Topic:

Year Group: Year 6

Length of session: One hour

Duration	Session Breakdown
8 mins	Welcome, health & safety & introduction to the library.
	Setting the scene for this session and sharing local history resources if available for the locality*. These can be left on display for viewing & further study by children for the duration of the session.
	Divide children into 3 groups.
	45 minutes for all group activities – led by librarian and supported by teaching staff. Divided up as follows:
15 mins	Group 1: Questionnaire using library books (specifically chosen children's fiction and information books suitable for a range of abilities) and / or local studies materials (if available for the locality)
	Group 2: Craft activity – make a cave painting
	Group 3: Using online resources for information retrieval. Includes multiple choice quiz.
15 mins	Group 1: Using online resources for information retrieval. Includes multiple choice quiz.
	Group 2: Questionnaire using library books (specifically chosen children's fiction and information books suitable for a range of abilities) and / or local studies materials (if available for the locality)
	Group 3: Craft activity – make a cave painting
15 mins	Group 1: Craft activity – make a cave painting
	Group 2: Using online resources for information retrieval. Includes multiple choice quiz.
	Group 3: Questionnaire using library books (specifically chosen children's fiction and information books suitable for a range of abilities) and / or local studies materials (if available for the locality)
7 mins	Gather back together, recap learning, talk through next steps (eg library joining)

NB: If children want to borrow books as part of this visit, this can be done either after the end of the session, or in small groups of 4-5 during the activities.

^{*} If the locality has local history relevant to this topic, information on this topic could be incorporated too, for example old newspaper reports of archaeological discoveries, photographs and maps.
